**October 6<sup>th</sup>, 2008**

Vice-President Karen Nadolski called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M., with 10 members present.

**Secretary's Report:**

The Secretary's report for August was reviewed. A motion was made by Howard Mulloy to approve the minutes, seconded by Cindy Helm, and approved by all.

**Treasurer's Report:**

The Treasurer's report is showing that we have \$16,035.41 in the DDA account and 2 CD's. One is \$11,929.22 that is due to mature on November 17, 2008, currently at a rate of 2.5%. The other CD is \$16,617.46, due to mature on March 18, 2009, at a rate of 3.003%. Total assets are \$44,582.09 as of September 30, 2008. Laurie Williams made a motion to approve the treasurer's report, seconded by Marge Kreienbrink, and approved by all.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

**Knife Sales** - Gerry Kultgen has been managing the knife sales by herself and brought some of the knives in to show the group. The most popular product right now is the tomato slicer.
