The OCArc is the primary advocacy organization in Ozaukee County for persons with developmental and related disabilities.

The OCArc considers cash grants to Ozaukee County organizations that conduct activities for persons with disabilities which are consistent with the OCArc's mission and its four areas of focus: Education, Socialization, Advocacy and Outreach.

The OCArc owns two homes in Port Washington that are designed to serve the needs of 16 individuals with disabilities. Contracted agencies manage and operate these homes.

The Mary Bowen Scholarship is awarded by the OCArc to a deserving and qualified student working toward a career that will serve persons with disabilities.

Today, services for citizens with disabilities that we often take for granted were non-existent when the OCArc was formed. Since its formation, the OCArc has been advocating for greater rights and improved benefits which will enrich the lives of persons with developmental disabilities in our community. Those who advocate need to continue to make advances to improve the quality of life for those that cannot easily represent themselves. We need to make certain that future Ozaukee County citizens with disabilities can realize, appreciate, and benefit from gains made by our advocacy today.
